

## H. Hygiene Policy Statement

It is the Company's intention that the production of food from a vending machine or kitchen should be without risk of contamination to the consumer.

Strict adherence to the following regulations is mandatory: -

1. All employees and assessors will maintain very high standards of personal cleanliness, and will wear the protective clothing provided when on site visits.
2. Employees and assessors suffering from infections which could cause food to be contaminated directly or indirectly must contact the Head Office prior to attending a food production area.
3. All employees and assessors will be medically screened prior to employment.
4. Any condition laid down in the Food Safety Regs. 1995, Food Hygiene (Scotland) Regulation 1959 and any other subsequent relevant Acts of Parliament must be observed by employees and assessors.
5. Any equipment, which comes into contact with food, will be kept in good order and repair so to ensure that it can be thoroughly cleaned, will not be absorbent and will not contaminate food.
6. All employees and assessors must observe all regulations laid down in this policy.
7. Uniforms must not be worn during the journey to work.
